

Safety and security

Contractors, suppliers and customer trainees:

This leaflet outlines the most important safety, security and knowledge protection issues you must be aware of while on ASML premises.

Your safety and security are a top priority for us when you visit our sites. The guidelines and rules in this leaflet are for everyone’s well-being and protection, so please read it carefully. Everyone must comply with these rules – you may be removed from the premises or otherwise penalized in the event of noncompliance.

- Your green badge entitles you to move around the campus unaccompanied. Please note the following:
- For the sake of safety and security, we log your use of the badge.
 - Your badge is for your personal use only. Never give it to anyone else or use it to give anyone else access to our buildings.
 - Wear the badge visibly at all times while you are on ASML premises.
 - If your badge is lost or stolen, please report this at the nearest reception desk or call 203 761 4161.

Safety training for contractors











All contractors must follow the requirements for contractor safety, which are explained in dedicated training sessions. Sessions occur multiple times a month. Please contact your Project Manager to register.

Reporting incidents

Please report any incidents, or unsafe or suspicious circumstances or behavior, to Security immediately: call **203 761 4161** or **ext. 4161**.



Note that there is 24/7 camera surveillance on ASML premises. There is 24/7 security present.

Please remember to

-  - Make sure your ASML badge is visible at all times.
-  - Comply with all ASML safety, security and traffic indications.
-  - Park only in the designated (visitor) parking spaces.
-  - Keep all fire extinguishing equipment and emergency exits free.
-  - Strictly follow all ASML safety and security instructions given by the emergency response team or other authorized personnel.
-  - Only use audio-visual recording devices (such as cameras, smartphones, voice recorders and tablets) to take photographs, films or audio recordings, if they have been approved by the ASML Communications Department.
-  - Only view, copy or take ASML information after receiving approval from the information owner.
-  - Use any public network other than ‘ASML_Public’ to conduct ASML business.
-  - Engage with ASML employees and other visitors in a polite and respectful way.
-  - Smoke only in the designated smoking areas.

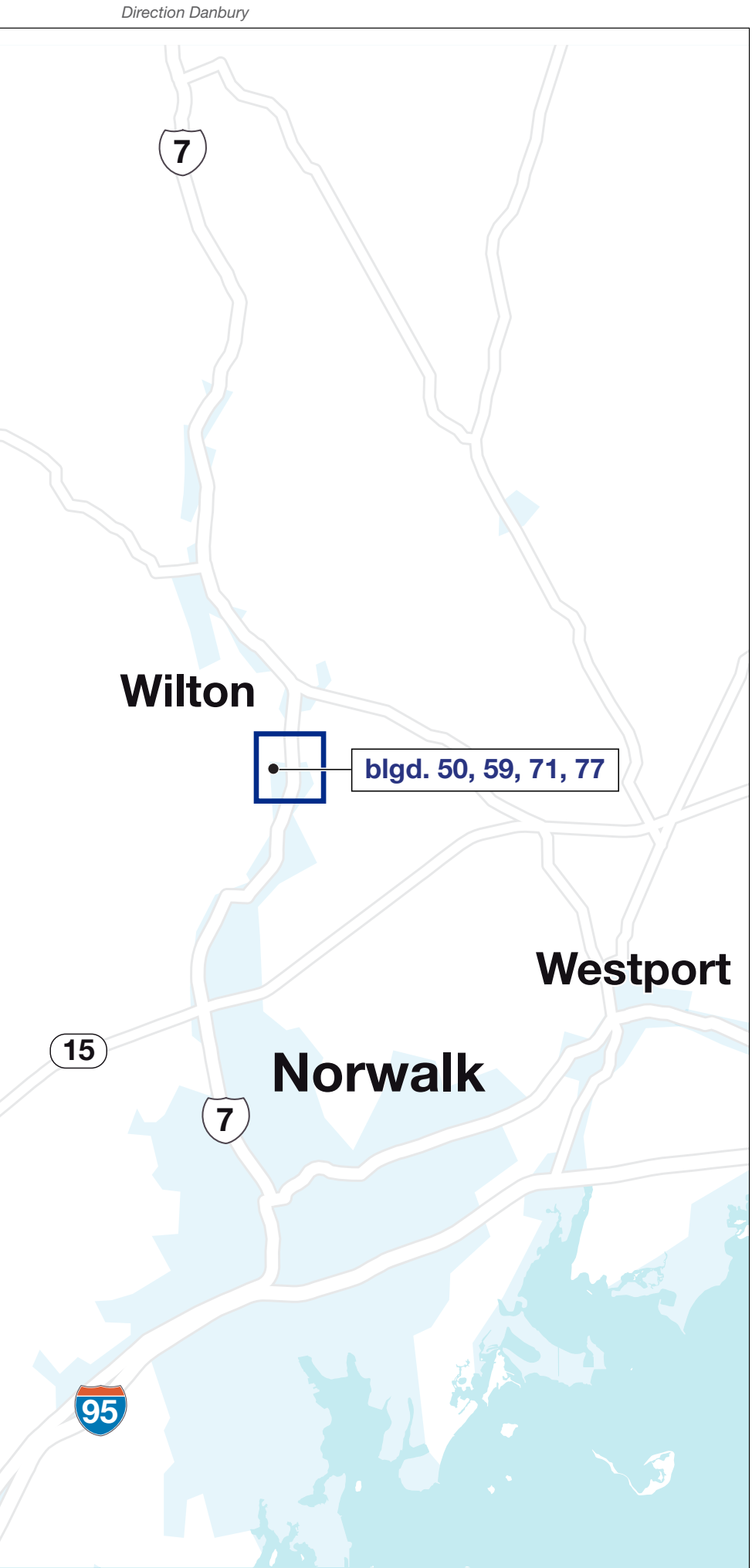
If you do not comply with these safety & security rules, you risk endangering yourself and others. ASML reserves the right to remove anyone from the ASML premises if these rules are not adhered to. Non-compliance can lead to a (temporary) denial of access to all ASML presises.

For contractors

-  - Any third parties conducting business on the ASML premises need a safety working permit.
-  - You can request more information about this permit from your ASML contract manager.
